Day 1

Depart Adelaide at 7.30am for Cape Jervis to join your 45-minute Sealink ferry crossing to Penneshaw on Kangaroo Island. You'll be met on arrival by your tour driver who will take you on a short tour of Penneshaw before arriving at the Dudley Wines Cellar Door for lunch. Visit Cape Willoughby Lighthouse and Antechamber Bay for a stroll along the beautiful, white sandy beach. Your accommodation is at the Mercure Kangaroo Island Lodge, American River where you will enjoy a 3-course dinner tonight.

Day 2

After breakfast you can take a leisurely walk to the site of a 19th century fish cannery. After morning tea, choose to take the 512 steps to the top of the highest point on the island – Prospect Hill for the most stunning views to both sides of the island or take a walk to on the wonderful surf beach of Pennington Bay. This afternoon you will have free time in the main island town of Kingscote and then visit Hope Cottage Museum for a fascinating insight in to the unique history and heritage of Kangaroo Island before arriving at the Aurora Ozone Hotel and dinner.

Day 3

This morning after breakfast you'll visit Shep's Studio, a working studio and gallery of artist, Neil Sheppard. Then it's on to the lovely Emu Bay Lavender Farm, a beautifully presented farm showcasing a range of lavender varieties. Enjoy morning tea here before heading off to the North Coast and to Stokes Bay's hidden beach, a stunning location. Lunch is at the Rockpool Café at Stokes Bay before heading off through the middle the island to the South Coast where you will be amazed by the Birds of Prey – Raptor Display, an interactive and educational experience and then Seal Bay Conservation Park for a guided beach walk amongst a colony of wild Australian sealions. This evening will finish at Vivonne Bay the only safe harbor on the south coast of the island and the base for cray fishing boats from November to May. Your accommodation for the next two nights is Vivonne Bay Lodge.

Day 4

After breakfast it's off to Flinders Chase National Park to enjoy spectacular coastal views on the way to Remarkable Rocks. Take a walk around these spectacular boulders which have been carved into many different weird and wonderful shapes by the wind and the ocean spray over many centuries. Drive past the ruins of an early settlement at Weirs Cove before going on to the Cape du Couedic Lighthouse built in 1906, and the natural land bridge that is "Admirals Arch". Look out for the New Zealand Fur Seals frolicking in the water and on the rocks under the arch. Enjoy an Aussie style country lunch at Vivonne Bay Lodge and then take time out to relax at the Lodge where you can take a nice leisurely bush walk, bike ride or kayak along the Harriet River.

Day 5

This morning we will say goodbye to the Vivonne Bay Lodge and transfer back to Penneshaw for our 10.30am ferry ride back to the mainland. Our coach will then tour us through the beautiful Fleurieu Peninsula to McLaren Vale where we will stop for lunch at Oscars, right in the main street for lunch before arriving back in Adelaide mid-afternoon after a most amazing 5 days on Kangaroo Island.
